



Dispose your sanitary waste with a RED  DOT

As per the new Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules notified by the Ministry of Environment and Forests, it is mandatory for every household to keep sanitary waste including diapers, incontinence sheets, condoms, and sanitary napkins segregated at source in clearly marked bags which are to be provided by manufacturers of these products. This waste can be put into the dry waste bin or handed over separately to a door step SWaCH collector. We urge the households of Pune to take this rule into cognizance and ensure compliance

SWaCH Seva Sahakari Sanstha Maryadit has been manufacturing bags with a clearly marked label for safe disposal of sanitary napkins. However, with the introduction of this new rule, it is now binding on every household to keep and dispose this waste as per the rules. We now ask that all citizens

You can use a red marker and ensure that the red dot is **big** and **visible**



This is to protect wastepickers from manually handling sanitary waste.

Rule 4(b) of the new SWM Rules, 2016 provides that “every waste generator shall wrap securely the used sanitary waste like diapers, sanitary pads etc., in the pouches provided by the manufacturers or brand owners of these products or in a suitable wrapping material as instructed by the local authorities and shall place the same in the bin meant for dry waste or non-biodegradable waste.”
